Summary report

The application form received 29/09/2020 with supporting info received 12/10/2020 and 29/11/20 indicates a strong overall environmental commitment, a good overview of the organization's willingness to follow up public expectations towards Environmental Management. This is evidenced in both the application and the supporting documents that are provided, which includes an extensive list of actions that are likely to help the organisation fulfil its environmental commitment.

Through the ECO-point score from 2017 to 2019, the result expresses a continual improvement of the score. From 67% in 2017 and 80 % in 2019. This survey, actions, and the event commitment, (evidenced through the supporting documents) indicate a solid insight and overview, that respond to most of the FIA requirements.

However, for future accreditation processes, it must be secured compliance with the FIA Accreditation Framework (see below).

Conclusion and recommendations

Based on the information received the FIA auditor have evaluated the overall performance and recommend the **St. Ursanne-Les Rangiers Hill Climb organiser to be awarded with the FIA One-Star Environmental Accreditation.**

Furthermore, the FIA auditor have observed the following areas for improvement:

- It is advised to develop an event specific Environmental Management manual where the overall commitment and all practical actions goes « hand in hand » with the FIA Environmental Accreditation framework (One Star level).
- It is advised to develop an event specific Environmental Policy that secure a formalized commitment (to conduct the actions presented in the supporting documents) from the event management.
- It is advised to develop future Environmental Objectives & Targets that are as much as possible “SMART” (S=Specific / M=Measurable / A=Achievable / R=Relevant / T=Timebound) to ensure that the event management can report progress over time.
- Be able to describe how compliance with laws and regulations is monitored (checked and reported) within the organization.
- Whether communication activities and initiatives have been/are being carried out to support the Environmental Policy and promote it toward internal and external audiences.
- How can the information have collected for the event`s key environmental impacts – being used as a baseline for improvement.
